

# 23 Point DIY Maintenance Program

## **Water Chemical Maintenance, and Checking Pool Chemicals**

1. Maintain proper water level
2. Chlorine - maintain
3. Chloramines - maintain
4. Total Chlorine (includes Chloramines) - maintain
5. pH (Potential Hydrogen) - maintain
6. TA (Total Alkalinity) - maintain
7. Calcium Hardness (Water Hardness) - check (this is a startup chemical)
8. Cyanuric Acid (Stabilizer / Conditioner) - check (this is a startup chemical)
9. Temperature (For pH Factor Calculation) - check
10. Saturation Index (Calcium Precipitation Point) - check
11. Salt Content - maintained on saltwater pools
12. Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) – check

## **Pool Equipment Checks- Keep the pool equipment operating and approve repairs when needed**

1. Skimmer baskets checked and emptied
2. Pump strainer baskets checked and emptied
3. Filter backwashing monthly for DE Filters and weekly for Sand Filters
4. Sweep debris bags checked and emptied
5. Sweep finger screen / wall screen checked and cleaned
6. Sweep operation checked
7. Valves monitored / maintained for suction and circulation adjustments
8. Be on a HST preventative maintenance service plan for your automatic cover system - every season!

## **Pool Cleaning**

1. Brush walls and steps
2. Brush spa
3. Net pool surface and pool bottom
4. Hose Vacuum
5. Venturi / Leaf Vacuum
